Academic Affairs Committee Minutes for October 29, 2013 Approved November 19, 2013

Members present: Patricia Murphy, Dan Jones, Andrea Dziubek, Roger Cavallo, Linda Weber, Elizabeth Campbell, Daryl Lee, John Lasher.

- 1. Committee approved the minutes of the September 19, 2013 meeting.
- 2. The committee tabled approval of the minutes of April 16, 2013 meeting until the November meeting in order to review more fully.
- 3. D. Lee reminded members of Academic Affairs that Middle States General Education working group is looking for a member to represent the committee. Interested members may email the chair of AA.
- 4. D. Lee informed the committee that no meetings of the Middle States working groups on Standards 1 or 6 have met, but that once the meetings take place he will inform AA of the tasks assigned to the committee.
- 5. Committee discussed the SUNYIT transfer grade policy in light of SUNY's mandate for campuses to establish such a policy. J. Lasher informed the committee that SUNYIT currently does not have a campus-wide uniform policy; rather individual programs transfer in courses in different ways. The committee recognized that the adoption of a campus-wide policy would have the effect of determining the minimum grade that native students would be required to earn in order to earn credit for a course. The committee expressed general consensus that programs should be able to maintain a minimum C grade requirement for required/core courses in their major. Discussion then focused on the appropriate minimum grade requirement for other courses, in particular General Education courses and elective courses; the pros and cons of a C, C-, D+, and D minimum transfer grade for such courses was discussed.
- 6. D. Lee requested that in preparation for the next meeting that members review the documents related to Undergraduate TA policies and review the Civil Engineering four year program as a possible standard template for publishing Four Year Program plans.
- 7. Meeting adjourned.
