

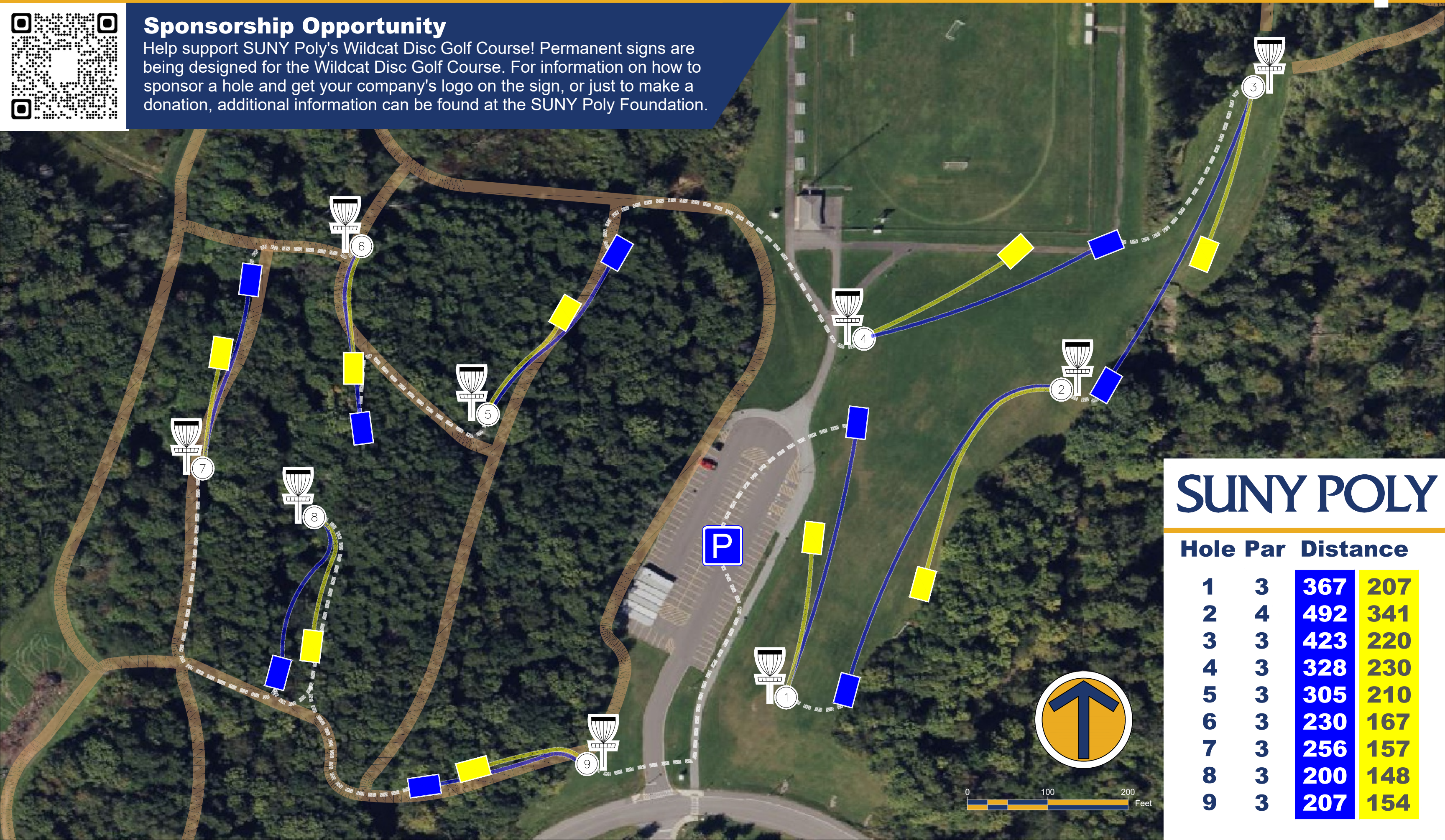

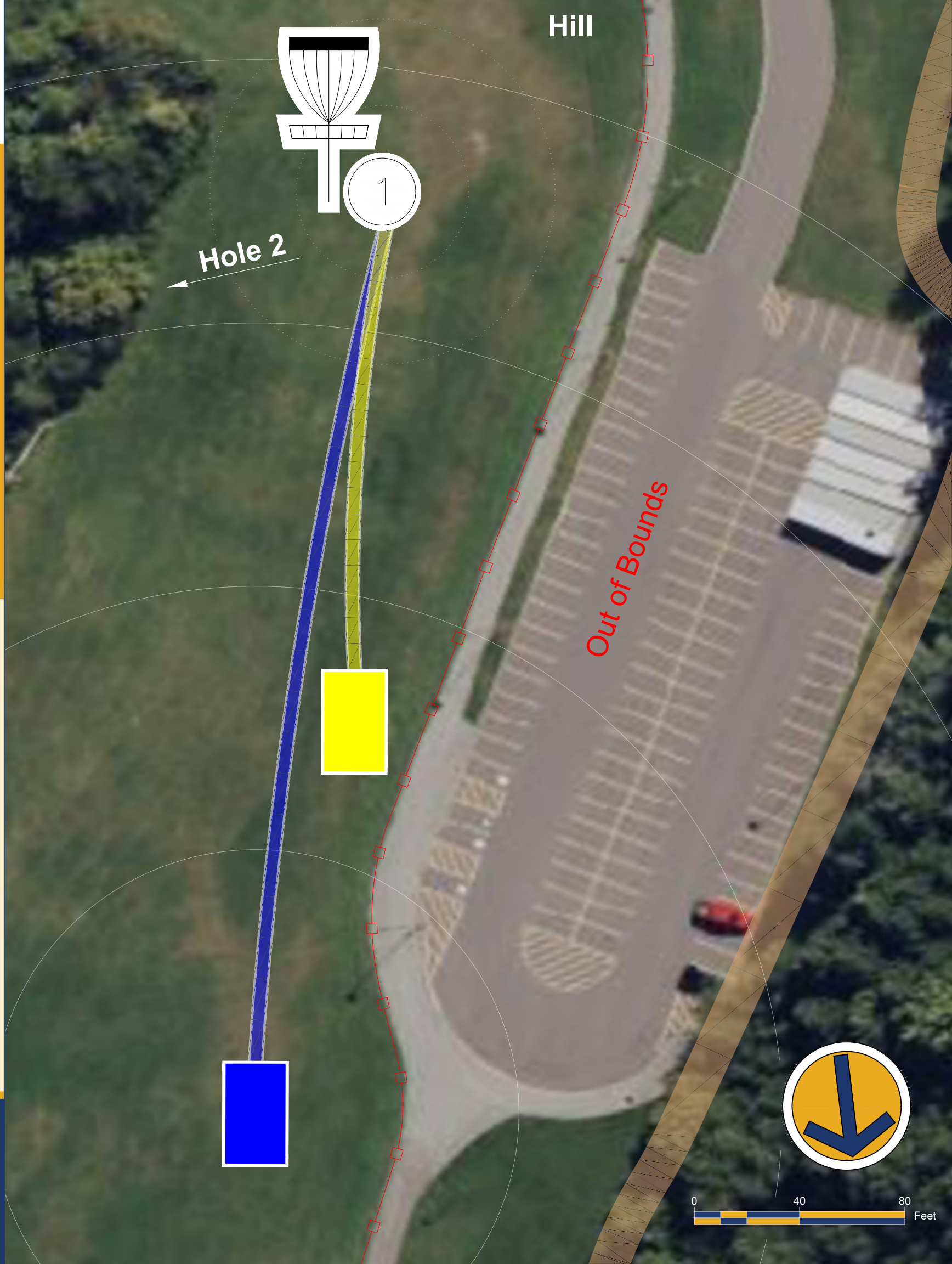
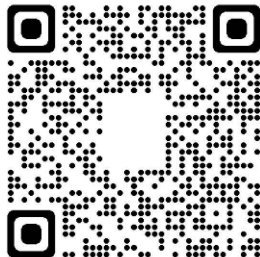
Hole Notes

Welcome to Hole 1! This hole is a straight shot, but be careful! If you throw your drive too far, you might find your disc rolling down the hill. If you lay up short, you might be facing a death putt.

The sidewalk and parking lot are out of bounds (OB). Any discs that land OB should be moved back to the grass in a line perpendicular to the curb. A one stroke penalty shall be assessed.

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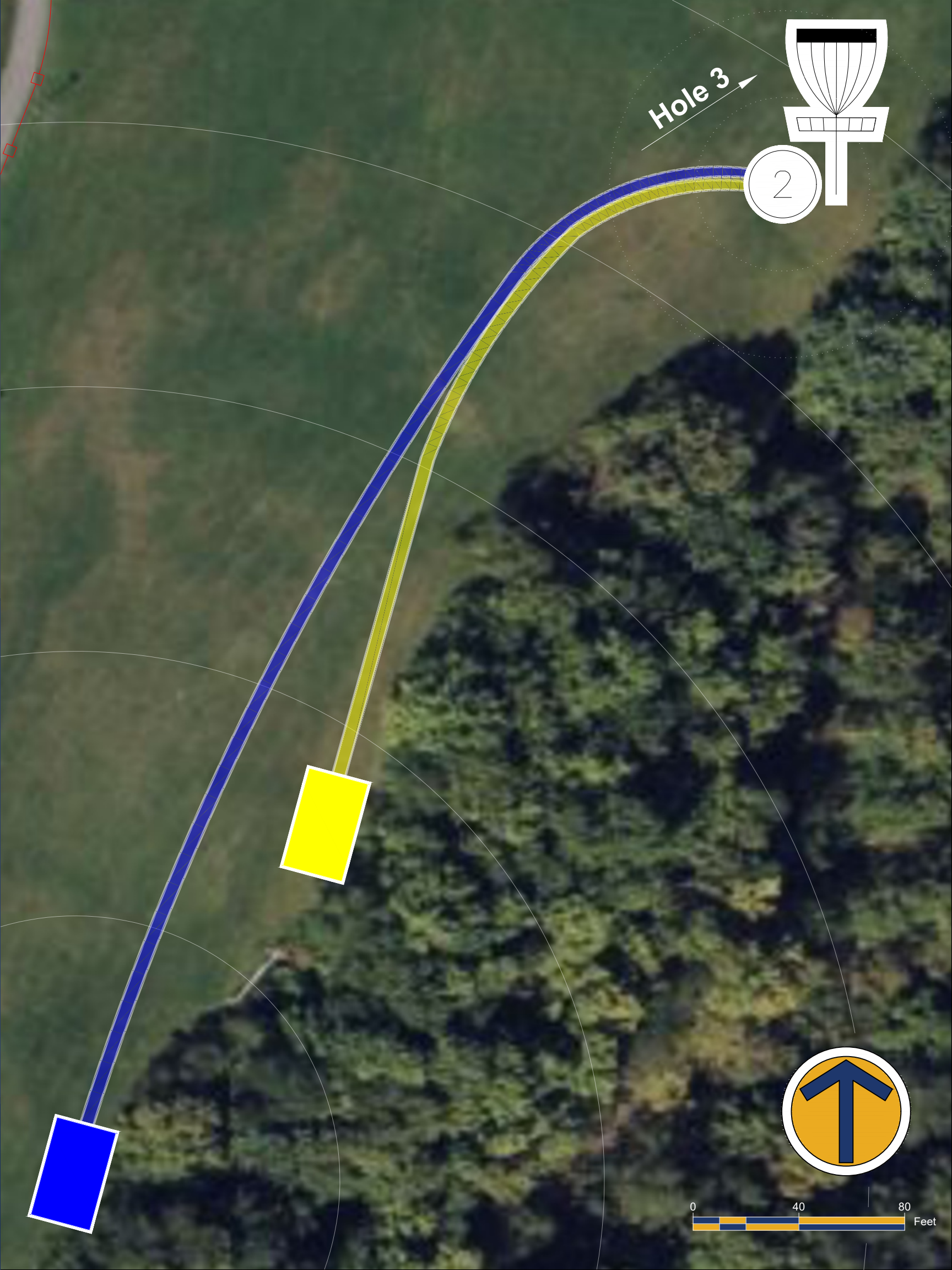
Hole Notes

Hole 2 is the longest on the North Nine. Play this hole away from the trees as they are thick. You don't want to lose your disc in there! It plays as a dogleg to a hidden basket on the right. The sidewalk edge is still out of bounds.

The SUNY Poly cross-country course starts in this field and follows the line for Holes 2 and 3. The baskets for these holes were placed to avoid conflict with the runners.

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Hole Notes

Although Hole 3 is not in the woods, it still requires some shot precision. Try to hit the middle of the fairway with your drive to allow for a clear second shot and putt.

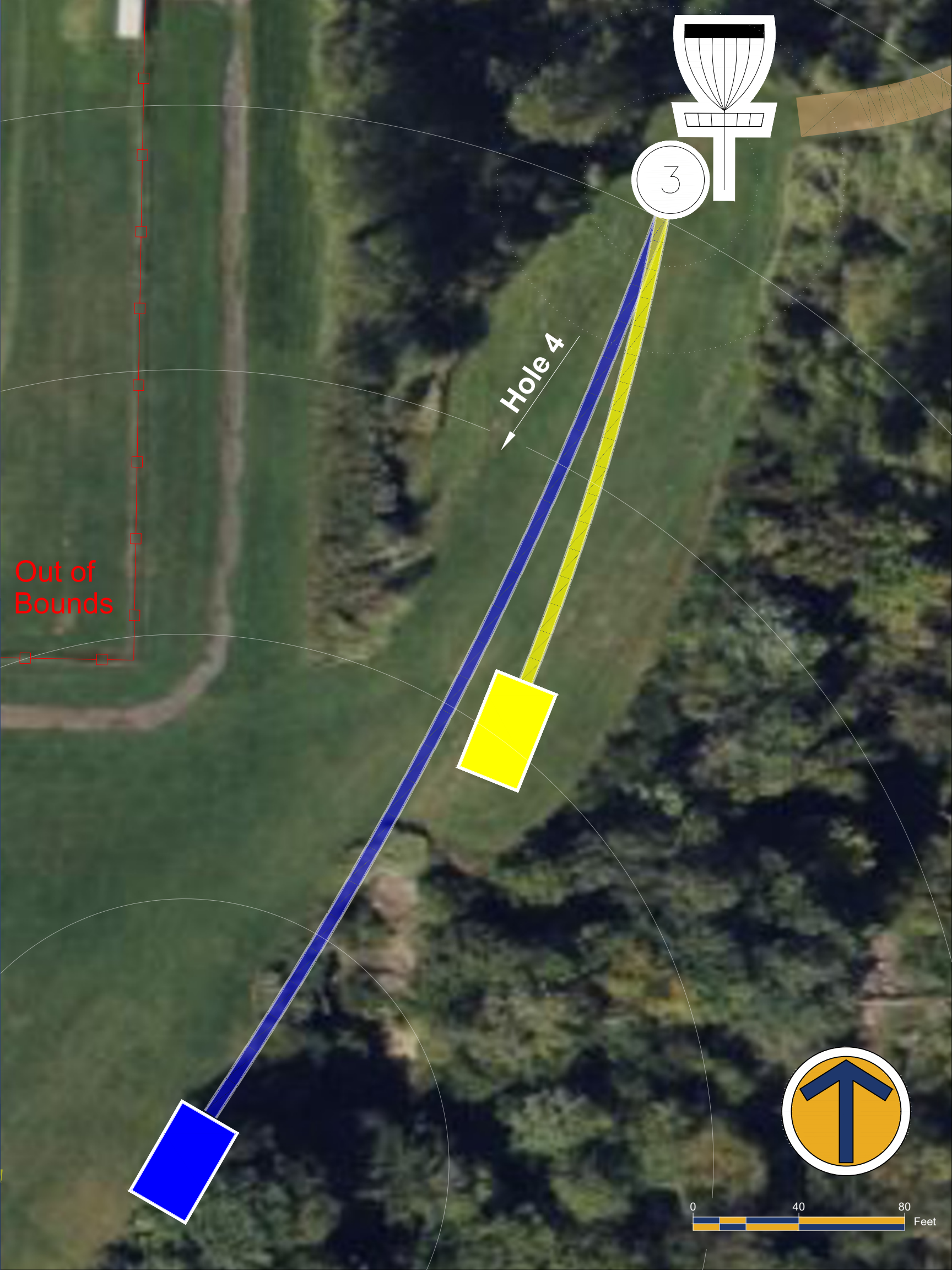
The rough on either side of the fairway is pretty thick. If you're worried about losing your disc with the blue tee, consider playing from the yellow tee.

Also, have a seat on the bench for a quick break!

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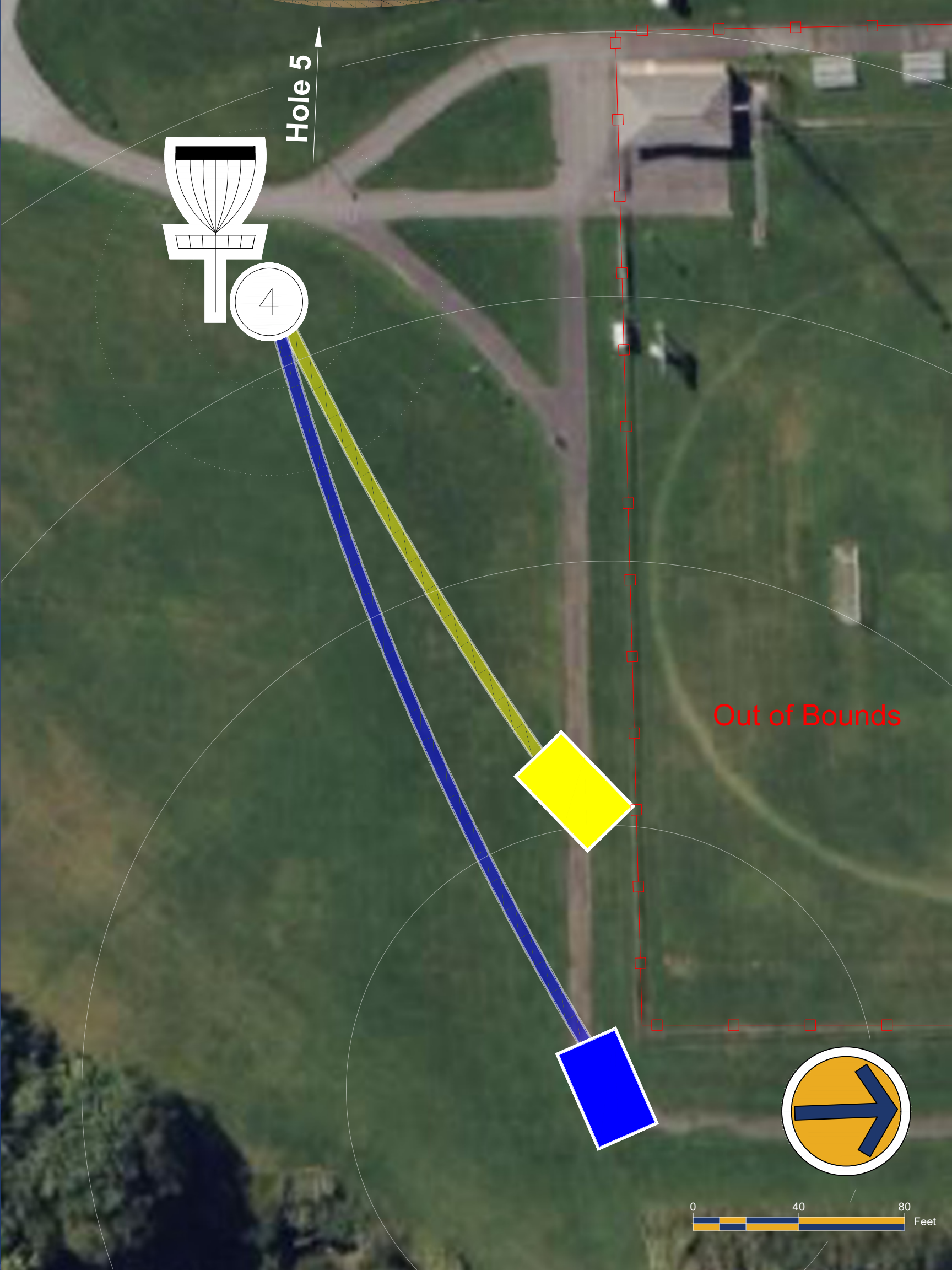

Enjoy the paved tees on this hole! Take advantage of the surface to maximize the run-up on your drive.

A fence to the right of the tee pad plays as out of bounds. If you find your disc ending up across the fence in the soccer field, move it back to the fairway side at the edge of the walkway in a line perpendicular to the fence and take a one stroke penalty. Please also watch out for the light poles.

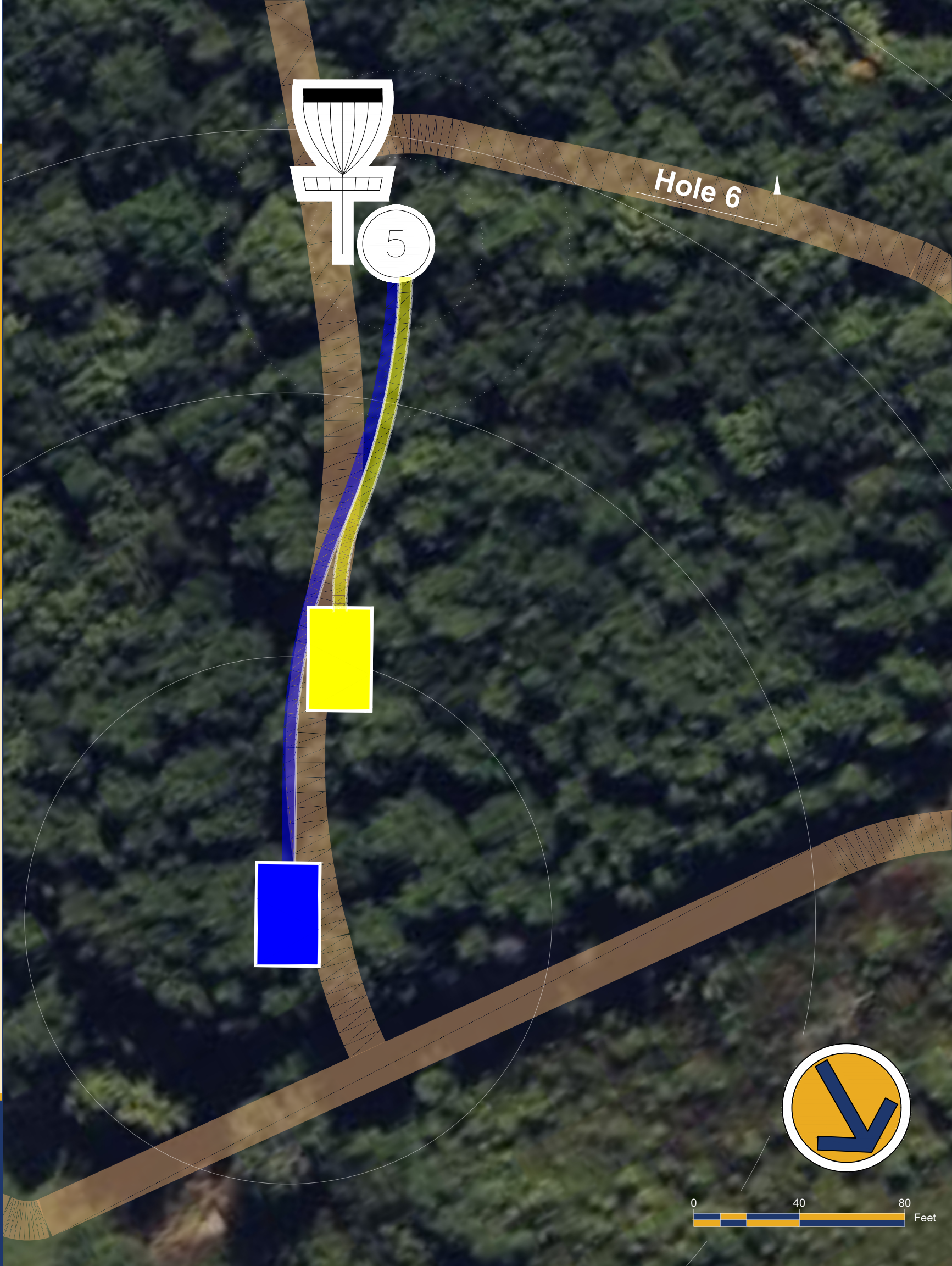
Hole 5 is the first in the woods on the North Nine. Please keep watch for people on the trails.

Try to send your drive through the gap with a slight fade to the right. Also, watch out for trees!

As you play the woods holes, feel free to lend a hand with trail maintenance by moving sticks to the side and putting garbage in the can by the basket on 5.

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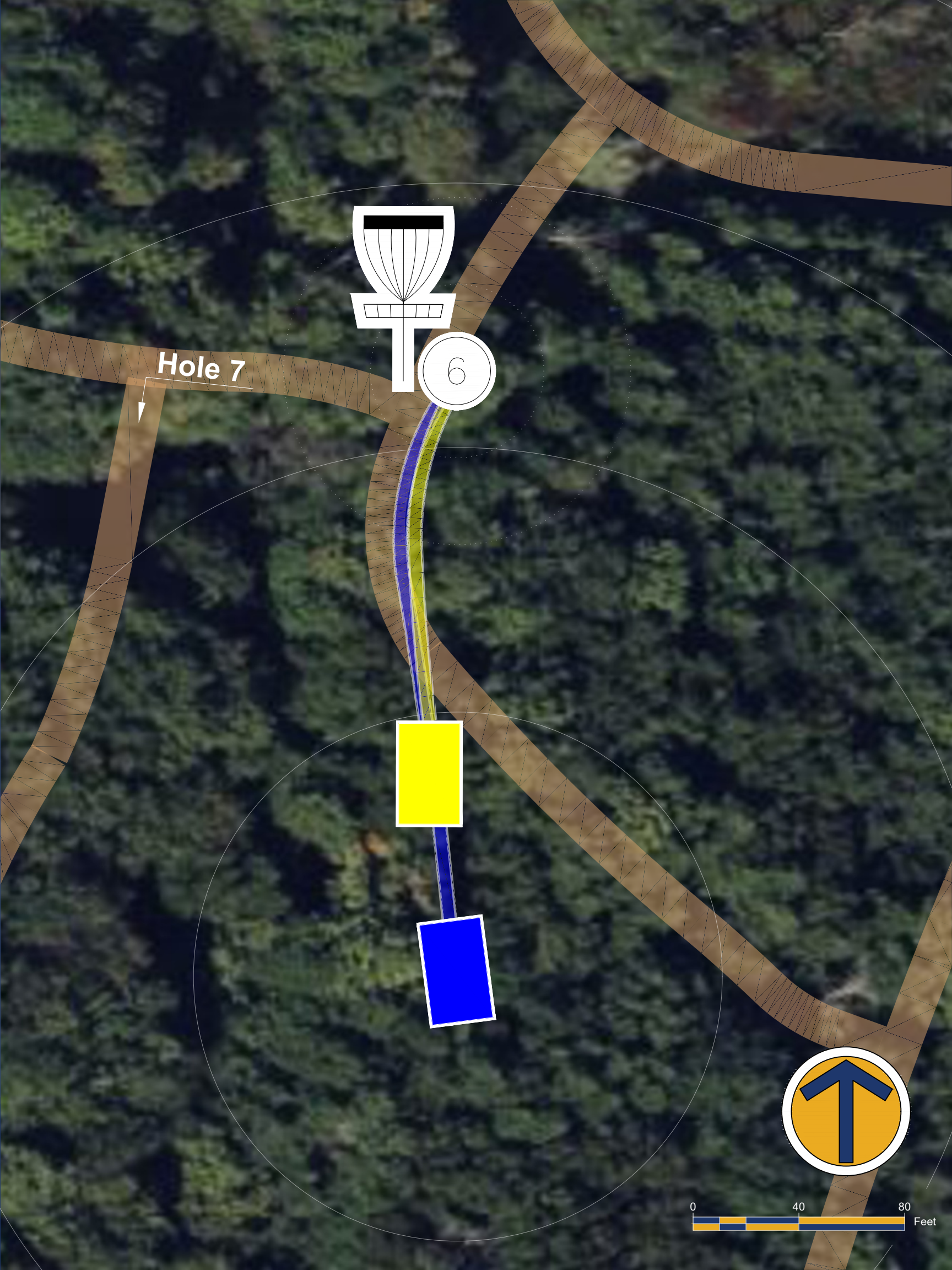
Hole Notes

The tee for Hole 6 is the only one in the woods of the North Nine that is significantly off the main trail. Once you find it, you'll see a couple of lines to approach the basket on 6. Both lines require you to find your way around a clump of trees just before the basket.

A drive on this hole can fade left along the trail or right into the gap. Parking either shot provides a look at the basket for birdie.

Hole 7 gives you a chance to flex your skills and perhaps your shot. The tee, which is slightly elevated from the trail, provides a line that is guarded on both sides by trees.

There is a clearing on the right side of the trail before the basket that provides a potential landing spot for a drive. A good drive is a setup for success on this hole.

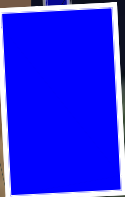
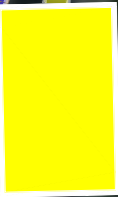

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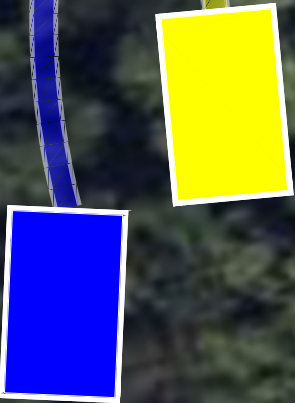
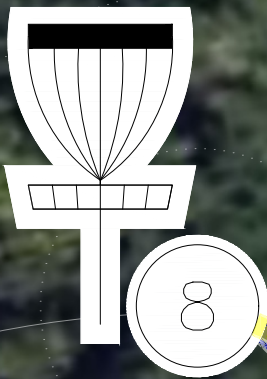
Hole Notes

The drive requires a shot up the ravine with a late left fade to a slightly elevated basket. Although the water is minimal, a shot that lands in water also lands you a one stroke penalty.

The trail from the tee to the basket has many roots and rocks. Watch your step! If playing with a cart, consider leaving the cart at the tee box and coming back out to get it before proceeding to Hole 9.

From the tee box for Hole 9, you should be able to just see the top yellow ring of the basket. The basket is protected by a few large trees on the right side of the trail. Try to curve your drive to the right around the trees at the top of a hill with your first shot.

While you should not be anywhere close to the road or parking lot, landing in either of these is out of bounds and incurs a one stroke penalty.

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
