GHG Emissions Inventory and Report

- We conducted a greenhouse gas emissions inventory for the Utica campus as part of a class project for BIO 106 Solutions for a Sustainable World (Bremer). Five students collaborated with the instructor. Utica Facilities provided <u>data</u>. Albany Facilities is unable to share data. We are using an online emissions calculator called <u>CarbonMAP</u>.
- Based on the GHG inventory, we will create a Climate Action Plan for setting emissions reductions goals and a timeline for implementing the plan. Alternatively, grant money is available for the <u>REV Campus Challenge Roadmaps Technical Assistance Program</u>.

SUNY Performance Improvement Fund Application

Green Building LEED Certification By Student Applied Learning Project Proposal \$250K was accepted by SUNY System Admin, but requested that we reapply for <u>Clean Energy Workforce Opportunity Program fund (\$950K)</u>. As a requirement we are seeking industry partners for consulting expertise and jobs pipeline commitments. MB attended High Needs group meeting at SUNY System Admin Building, Albany Sept 6, 2017.

Forest Carbon Inventory project

Basal area of fifteen 1/10 acre plots measured by students in BIO 300 Ecology course.
Purpose is to quantify a baseline amount of aboveground carbon in campus forest trees.
Remeasurement every 5 years allows for calculation of annual carbon sequestration rate which can be applied toward campus carbon budget/ (future) neutrality goal.

Tree Campus USA application?; 5 requirements

- 1. Establish a Campus Tree Advisory Committee
- 2. Create a Campus Tree Care Plan
- 3. Show dedicated annual funds allocated to tree care
- 4. Organize an Arbor Day observance
- 5. Conduct a service learning project
