The 18-member Search Committee consists of four members of the College Council, six faculty members, one student, one staff member, one SUNY Poly alumni, one Dean, one foundation representative, one member of the SUNY Chancellor's senior staff, and two SUNY System liaisons. The Search Committee is an essential representation of the great work that happens at SUNY Poly every day, and we are committed to the future success of the university.
