Definition of Independent Study and Credit Value: An independent study is defined as "study given initial guidance, criticism, review and final evaluation of student performance by an instructor. One credit for Independent Study will be awarded for the equivalent of forty-five 50-minute sessions {37.5 clock hours} of student academic activity". Two credits is 75 clock hours, three credits is 112.50 clock hours, and four credits is 150 clock hours of student academic activity. Undergraduate students may apply no more than eight (8) credits of Independent Study coursework to a degree program.

Instructions: To register for an Independent Study, the student must complete this form in concert with the instructor. The form must be signed by that instructor and submitted to the department chairperson for approval. The chairperson forwards the approved form to the Registrar's Office for processing and registration.
